King's Cross Story Palace is a two year HLF funded project led by Historypin and the Building Exploratory. We aim to create a community-led history of the King's Cross area over the past 100 years. We'll do this through a programme of story gathering activities, public events, exhibitions and printed materials.

The Role

We are looking for volunteers to support the community outreach and story gathering activity across all our key audience groups, working closely with the project's Community Officers.

The role will involve:

- Helping with workshops and community events for local residents, groups and organisations
- Working with diverse groups of older people, unemployed people, young people and school groups
- Making links with new groups and organisations
- Conducting and supporting life story interviews
- Helping to transcribe and edit stories
- Publicising the project across the King's Cross area
- Collecting feedback from participants
